Waiharakeke Grass Skink Found in Marlborough and North-eastern parts of the

South Island.

Marlborough Mini Gecko

Found in non-forested regions of Marlborough, north-east Nelson, and northern Canterbury. A population is also present on the western coastline of Wellington.





Plague Skink

Native to Australia but sadly now found in many regions of NZ. Auckland, Whanganui, Palmerston North, Foxton Beach and Marlborough.

Marlborough Green Gecko

Restricted to the northern Marlborough region, bounded to the east by the Wairau River. Occurs on a large number of islands throughout the Marlborough Sounds.
