Set up time: All stalls must be set up no later than 9:30am and remain open until 3:00pm

Location: Baden Powell Reserve, Pollard Park (Blenheim)

Envirohub Marlborough's Earth Day Picnic in Park 2024 is a ZERO WASTE event. By completing this form you are agreeing to implement this policy with the support of Envirohub Marlborough who will be providing advice and guidance prior to the event and supporting these efforts on the day.

Stall sites: Generally, stall site spaces are 3m x 3m, however, larger sites may be provided upon request. Vehicles may be permitted on site subject to consent from the event manager. All vehicles MUSt be removed from the event grounds no later than 9:30am. Vehicles may NOT return onto the grounds until 3:00pm. Vendors must clearly display the name of their business and post prices of items being sold. Stallholders must provide and set up their own sturdy and secure trestle tables, umbrellas/gazebos or marquees and ensure these are weighted down appropriately.

Stallholder duties: As a zero waste event, we expect you pack in and pack out - that is please take any waste produced by your stall on the day back with you for appropriate recycling or disposal. Please keep the area around your stall clean during and after the event. If you are providing food, you MUST utilise reusables that can be provided for you by our Zero Waste service on the day. We are happy to provide more details on this service.

Stall licences/H&S: It is the stallholders responsibility to abide by all local body and national regulations that are applicable. Certificates are to be displayed for public viewing where appropriate.

It is the stallholder's responsibility that if the stall is categorised as a Food Stall by Marlborough District Council (MDC), they must ensure their stall is registered as a Food Stall and certified to meet the criteria as set by MDC. All food vendors must also have a health and safety policy available for viewing on request where appropriate.

Stall fees: Stallholders are required to pay a \$20 site fee to secure your place to Envirohub Marlborough. This must be paid prior to the event and we are happy to issue an invoice on request. No refund will be given for cancelling within 20 days prior to the event. If the event is cancelled due to bad weather a full refund will be issued.
